

Technology Development & Utilization Programme for Women (TDUPW)

Eligibility

- **Direct:** Institutions receiving annual recurring grants from the Central or State Government Agencies including the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research, Indian Universities, academic institutions, R&D institutions, Public Sector Undertakings, etc.
- Institutions registered under the Societies Registration Act.
- Trusts registered under Indian Trusts Act
- R&D laboratories, scientific Institutions, particularly CSIR Laboratories.
- **Indirect:** Women/ Women Entrepreneurs

Support for: Promoting the adoption of new technologies by women, Awareness creation and training of women on technology related issues, Promoting technological up-gradation of MSMEs run by women SHGs/ entrepreneurs, Design and development of products, processes beneficial to women, Establishing Consultancy Cells for imparting technical knowledge on adoption of latest technologies, Showcasing of appropriate technologies and organizing demonstration programmes for the benefit of women and case studies on successful R&D and developed technology

Grant

The financial assistance will be provided only for meeting expenditure on Manpower, Consumables, Basic Equipment, travel within the country etc. No support will be provided for basic infrastructure and buildings. The assistance will be released in installments and will be linked to specific milestones achieved as per time schedule indicated in the proposal. The release would also be dependent on the completion of formalities like submission of progress reports and Utilization Certificates.

Other information:

Institutions, other than Government, are required to attach the following:

- A Copy of registration certificate and a copy of Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations/Trust Deed
- Copy of Annual report(giving details of the activities of the organization) of last 3 years
- Copy of the Annual Financial Statement (duly certified by an auditor)of last 3 years

The proposal may be submitted any time during the Financial year.
